

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Communications & Engagement Team along with the P&F Advisory Committee and volunteers have been hard at work putting together Rosebank's annual Trivia Night. This night is all about having fun with our Rosebank community, meeting new people and raising money for the College. Below are some FAQs that will hopefully answer any questions you may have.

When and where is the event?

Saturday, 19 August 2023. Doors open at 6pm, seats to be taken at 6.45pm (for a prompt 7pm start to trivia) in the Benedict Auditorium. This is a 3 hour event, finishing at 10pm.

Where do I buy tickets?

Tickets are on sale online until 8.00am Monday, 7 August 2023.

Who is hosting the Trivia Night?

Our trivia master is Sydney's number one trivia host, Time for Trivia! Anyone who attended last year will know Carrie brings the fun!

Who can attend the event?

This is an adult only event, with invitations extended to the Parents and Friends of the College.

Why does the P&F need to have a fundraising event?

Unlike many other schools that have a P&F levy included as part of school fees, Rosebank's P&F Advisory Committee raises all its funds through the help of volunteers. The Committee uses funds raised to purchase various items or upgrades for the College, and to help at various events such as the Parent Welcome and Information Evening and the Food Hall at Open Day.

What are we raising money for?

This year the P&F Advisory Committee is raising money toward the creation of a multi-functional, outdoor gathering space, at the heart of the College. This large-scale project will see the construction of a unique teaching and learning space, designed in consultation with students and staff, under the guidance of a landscape architect. The design of this space will pay homage to the traditional owners of the land, the Wangal people, as well as honouring the Good Samaritan Sisters

and the rich history of the College.

How does Trivia Night raise money?

- Ticket sales book your seats and get ready for a fun night!
- <u>Silent Online Auction and Raffle</u> this is your chance to support the College and take-home great products and services from our generous donors
- Games at the event bring plenty of gold coins as we'll have extra games and prizes you can win

Is the event BYO?

There will be tea and coffee available at the event, as well as water and soft drinks. All other food and drinks are BYO. Don't forget to bring your own cutlery, plates and cups too! Most people bring an esky or cooler bag with all of the food and alcohol they want for the night.

Is there a theme?

This year we've gone with a Christmas theme. Feel free to bring decorations that can bring your table to life or maybe even dress in theme for some fancy-dress fun! There will be a prize for the best dressed Santa, worst Christmas jumper, best dressed table. Dress up is optional so don't worry if you can't. (Please note: no balloons as part of College's sustainability goals).

What if I'm new to the school and don't know many people?

There will be tables set aside for individual ticket holders to get together, so you don't need to worry if you don't have a group organised to sit together as a team.

Will the tickets sell out?

Yes! Our College community is growing, and we will have a maximum capacity for the Benedict Auditorium, so don't miss out.

How do I buy tickets for raffle and auction items?

Silent auction items and tickets for raffle items are available for <u>online</u> purchase only. These will be available before the Trivia Night and during the event, with items closing during the Trivia Night. Raffle and auction item winners will be drawn via the online platform and notified via email.

Do I need to bring cash?

Yes, this is a fundraiser so there will be a few options on the night for you to contribute to the College and take home some great prizes. We'll have lots of additional games where you can use cash, EFTPOS and gold coins to win on the night.
