Responsibilities

- * To accept others both students and teachers and to treat them with understanding and compassion.
- * To treat others with politeness and respect and to follow College policies about bullying and 'hands off' play.
- * To respect the authority of teachers. If necessary, I should be able to disagree without being disagreeable but, ultimately, I must acknowledge the legitimate authority vested in College staff.
- * To exhibit willingness to learn self-control and self-discipline. In carrying out my rights, I have the responsibility not to deny the rights of others and I would expect to be corrected if I do so.
- * To cooperate with teachers and other students to make sure that lessons proceed productively and that I keep up to date with required work.
- * To behave so as not to interfere with other students' right to learn.
- * To be punctual, to attend classes regularly, be organised and to participate as fully as my talent allows in all areas of College life.
- * To care for the school environment both classrooms and outside areas. To keep clean and be prepared to remove litter.
- * To obey both the criminal law and College regulations in relation to alcohol, drugs, and motor vehicles.
- * To behave and wear my uniform correctly to show the community I have pride in the College.
