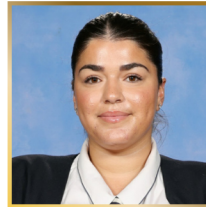
Archbishop of Sydney Award

Cormac Ryan is recognised for his exceptional commitment, persistence, dedication and the ability to overcome obstacles or difficulties.



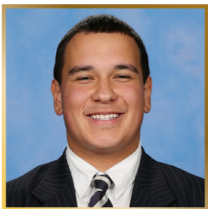
Ellen Fredericks Scholarship

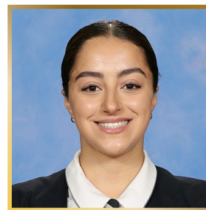
Ampol Best All Rounder Award

The Senior School Excellence Award in memory of Dylan Walker is presented to **Julian O'Donnell**.



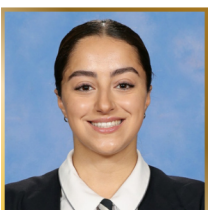
Overall Sporting Commitment Award
