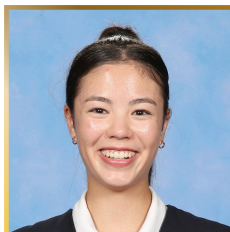

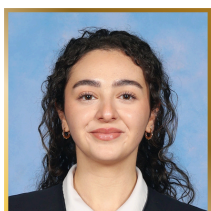
Ampol Best All Rounder Award

Olek Szczerbicki is recognised for showing unwavering commitment to his studies and has consistently exhibited leadership attributes and a dedication to service.



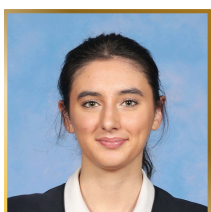
Senior School Excellence Award
