early entry quick facts study work grow

Last year saw a huge surge in early entry applications for students looking to get into university, so if you're thinking of heading off to uni in 2024, you might be keen to get started now.

Many early entry programs tend to open up for applications between April and June. And while you might hear back from some universities pretty quickly, for many of them you'll be waiting until at least September to receive an offer.

It's important to keep in mind that if you do receive an offer you may still need to meet certain requirements to keep it, like finishing Year 12 and receiving an ATAR.

ONE THIRD OF OFFERS WERE EARLY ENTRY

At least 50,000 early offers were made to Year 12 students in NSW, compared to over 95,000 offers made through UAC's standard application process
