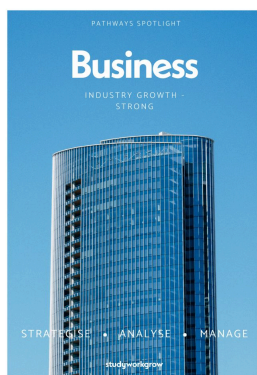

Adding Preferences:

You can add up to five course preferences using the course search within the application. Order your preferences starting with the course you'd most like to study.

Rest assured that if you change your mind, you can simply log in to your application later and update your preferences.

Special Course Requirements: When you add a course to your preference list, you'll see if it has extra requirements, such as a questionnaire or portfolio. You can go ahead and submit your application and complete those requirements later.
