# F.A.Q.

- All items of the College uniform (excluding shoes) are exclusively available through the Uniform Shop.
- Middle School (MS) Home Room is made up of students from Years 7 9
- Senior School (SS) Home Room is made up of students from Years 10 12
- Some items in the "Middle School Uniform" may be referred to as junior, e.g. "Girls junior dress"
- Students representing the College on any formal occasion, for example, Opening College Mass, onsite Learning Progress Meetings, Presentation Evening, Graduation, etc. are expected to be in full school uniform including the College blazer.
- The College jumper or vest may be worn at school during the day, or under the blazer to and from school.
- On Thursdays the College jumper may be worn at school during the day, or under the tracksuit jacket to and from school.
- Fittings: If you are in need of any uniform items which require a fitting, please contact the Uniform Shop directly to schedule an appointment.
- Online payments: Current families may now purchase Uniform Shop items online, for collection from the College. To make an online purchase, please visit the Parent Portal and select the 'Online Payments' icon.
- Girls tie: A girls tie needs to be worn with all formal school uniforms, except for the summer dress.
   Black socks should be worn with pants. If a belt is needed, it should be the school belt.

### **UNIFORM CODE**

The full College uniform code is printed in the front of the College Diary.

- Students in uniform represent the College.
- Students need to ensure their appearance reflects the standards of the College and their behaviour and interaction with members of the public is exemplary, both on campus, at other school activities, or in public.
- Correct uniform needs to be worn to and from the College.
- Students must wear the complete and correct version of the uniform. No mixing of pieces is allowed.

#### **JEWELLERY**

Jewellery is not to be worn except as follows:

- Earrings girls may wear one pair of plain gold or silver studs or sleepers in the lower part
  of their earlobe. Plastic studs are not acceptable. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings
  or clear plastic studs.
- Other forms of body piercing are not permitted, including eyebrow piercings and nose rings/studs.
- Rings students may wear one small ring, appropriate for wearing with school uniform.
- If a chain is worn, it should be worn inside the school shirt so as not to be seen. This includes chains displaying religious iconography.
- No bracelets or anklets are to be worn.

#### **HAIR**

- · Hairstyles are expected to be reasonably conservative and guided by common sense.
- Hair should be of a natural conservative colour. No excessive use of gel or inappropriate styling, for example: braiding with beading.
- In complying with WHS legislation, girls' hair which is longer than collar-length must be tied
  up
- and back and secured with a navy blue or white ribbon or clip.
- Boys' hair is to be short, neat and tidy, off the ears and face, and no longer than collarlength. Unacceptable styles include rat tails, mullets, lines and number one or zero buzz cuts, fades, steps and undercuts. Hair should be of a consistent length or blended. Long fringes are not permitted.
- If you have any doubts, please discuss it with the House Coordinator or the Assistant Dean of Pastoral Care first. In the final instance, the decision on whether a hairstyle is appropriate for school will be at the discretion of these members of staff.

#### **UNIFORM CODE**

#### **SCHOOL BAGS**

- All students are to have a College backpack and College sport bag.
- Students are to purchase and use the College sports bag for carrying sports gear and other additional items to school and for use on excursions.
- Sports bags are not to be used as a substitute for the College backpack.
- During the school day, all school bags are to be stored in lockers.



#### **OTHER**

- Make-up is NOT permitted to be worn at school. Students will be asked to remove make
  up.
- False eyelashes and eyelash extentions are not permitted.
- · For safety reasons, nails are to be kept short. Nail polish or acrylic nails are not permitted.
- Boys are to be clean-shaven each day. If unshaven, they will be sent to the General Office to shave.
- Visible tattoos are not permissible, including temporary tattoos and henna tattoos.

#### **MUFTI DAYS**

Students are occasionally allowed to wear 'mufti' or plain clothes to school, e.g. for fundrasing events or senior exams. On such occasions students are expected to be modestly attired and to wear clothes that are appropriate for the weather conditions and the event. On these days students must:

- Adhere to the College guidelines regarding hair and jewellery.
- · Wear covered shoes no thongs, scuffs or slides.
- Not wear revealing clothing including halter, strapless or crop tops, singlets, ripped jeans, or shorts above mid-thigh, or clothing that has inappropriate slogans.
